prayer lasts approximately 30 minutes. Why not enjoy the Athletic Association Fish Fry, then join us in church to pray the Stations!



The St. Dominic Parish St. Vincent de Paul Society which serves ALL the people in our territory which includes most of Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside would like to recruit some new members.

Since the need for help has increased over the last decade, so have the calls to the St. Dominic Parish St. Vincent de Paul hotline for food, furniture and clothing, as well as utility and rent assistance.

Because of the increased need and calls, we need more members in our St. Vincent de Paul Society who are capable of, and willing to make house calls. This is both a challenging and a rewarding opportunity for the volunteers. Volunteers need to be able to drive and should have at least limited computer skills.

Since most of the St. Vincent de Paul work is done during the day, this is a great opportunity for a retired person who wants to remain active. It is also a good opportunity for married couples because Vincentians always work in pairs.

Training is provided. Members answer phone calls received on the St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul hotline from their homes for a week at a time about once every six (6) weeks.

The St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society has weekly meetings on Monday evenings from 7:00-8:00 p.m. to discuss the activities of the previous week.


