Our thanksgiving needs to be more than just a pious thought of gratitude. It needs to be expressed by what we do with all of God's blessings. We have been blessed as a parish family! Our parish family is a blessing! The saints among us are a blessing! The most important thing we do as a parish is to gather each weekend for Eucharist. The word Eucharist is Greek and means "to give thanks!"

Say a prayer for our eighth graders who are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They will receive the sacrament on Tuesday, November 27. Bishop Joe Binzer will be with us for the celebration. Say a prayer, too, for our second graders who will receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time, on Monday, November 5. May they experience God's mercy on that night and throughout their lives!
