St. Dominic St. Vincent De Paul Society

We wish to extend a very big "THANK-YOU" to all the parishioners of St. Dominic. Through your generous donations, we were able to provide help to many families.

From April through June of 2016, your St. Vincent De Paul Society was able to help 74 families and 250 adults and children in the Delhi area. Our total receipts for the second quarter of this year was \$22,243 from poor box collections, parishioner donations, the schoolchildren and member donations. We were able to pay out \$12,078 in client aid during the three months of April, May and June. The breakdown is as follows:

- 1. (Religious education in St. Dominic School as well as Adult Religious education is benefiting from these sources as well!)
- 2. We are piloting online registration for the Preschool and Grade school PSR programs. The online form is on the Parish Website at www.stdominicdelhi.org. Click on Worship > Faith Formation > PSR > PSR registration. Registration is open from Wednesday, July 20-Wednesday, August 17.
- 3. First day of Class:

Preschool/Kindergarten: Sunday, September 11 at 9:30 a.m.

Grades 1-5: Sunday, September 11 at 10:30 a.m.

Grades 6-8: Tuesday, September 13 at 7:00 p.m.

Reminder to parents of PSR students in Grades 1-5 - Class will be held Sunday morning from 10:30-11:30 a.m. There are several reasons for this change, including providing 25% more class time for students, allows families to attend either 9:30 a.m. or 11:30 a.m. Sunday morning Mass and we can better accommodate students in all area public grade schools.
