Dear Parents:

Good Holy Thursday to you! Today marks the beginning of the **Easter Triduum which is the summit of the Liturgical Year** from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:

- Mass of the Lord's Supper
- Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
- Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord

Today our students attended a Prayer Service. I would like to thank Mrs. Daubenmerkel for all her hard work on this. What a moving experience for our students. I would also like to thank Deacon Mark Bardono who talked to our 6-8th graders on Wednesday morning about the "holy oils" used throughout not only our Easter Season but for other sacraments as well.

As we get ready to celebrate Easter my wish for you and your family is to have a Blessed Easter! My hope is that you celebrate as many of our Catholic Faith traditions in the next four days as your time permits. Now is the time to establish those traditions with your children so they in turn can pass them on to the next generation. Traditions are crucial to KEEPING OUR FAITH ALIVE!!!

LaSalle High School High School Placement Test Prep Course The High School Placement Test is required to be taken by any student interested in attending an Archdiocesan high school in Cincinnati. A total of two sessions will be held in June and August, the same material will be covered in each course. The course will focus on test taking skills and strategies while looking at an overview of the five sections the HSPT covers: Verbal, Quantitative, Reading, Mathematics, and Language. We offer a one day class that focuses on three main areas in final preparation for students to become acclimated to the High School Placement Test: (1) Test taking strategies, (2) speed and accuracy, (3) topic overview. TUITION DECREASED FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR!

It is with great pleasure that we announce that the tuition for the 2016-2017 school year has been reduced!!! The rate for one child will be reduced to \$2950 for the upcoming year (In- Parish tuition rate). This year, the Tuition Reduction Program earned a \$70 per student reduction. With the proposed tuition increase of \$0-\$25, this ultimately means a \$50 across the board decrease in tuition per student in grades K-8. Other income sources in our parish which include (1) Parish Festival, (2) generosity of Parishoners in our Archdiocese 1Faith 1Hope 1Love campaign and (3) generosity of a past Parishioner, who bequested a considerable sum to our Parish to be used for education throughout our Parish. Please know that more information will be forthcoming.

The success of the Tuition Reduction Program helped to reduce the cost of tuition by \$70 per student in grades K-8. In addition to lowering the cost of tuition, the Tuition Program has contributed over \$5,500 to the Sr. Patrick Ann Tuition Assistance Fund this year. Over the past 3 years, the Tuition Reduction Program has raised over \$100,000. 100% of the money earned by the Tuition Reduction Program is given back to St. Dominic School. 85% is given back to all students as a tuition reduction and the remaining 15% is given to the Sr. Patrick Ann Tuition Assistance Fund, which in turn helps our school families with the cost of tuition. 100% comes back to our school. This program is completely funded through the support of our school and parish families who link their Kroger Plus Cards, Remkes Markets Rewards Card, Shoparoo, Dinner to Donation fundraisers, and the Robben Florist fundraiser. Thank you to everyone who participates in the Tuition Program's many fundraisers and by linking your loyalty cards! The increase in the support of this program has made this year's tuition reduction possible. There is strength in numbers and this program is an example of that. With the continued support from out school and parish families, we can help to keep the cost of tuition at a reasonable amount. Thank you to everyone who supports this wonderful program! We are all in this together!

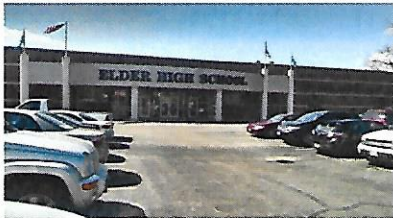
