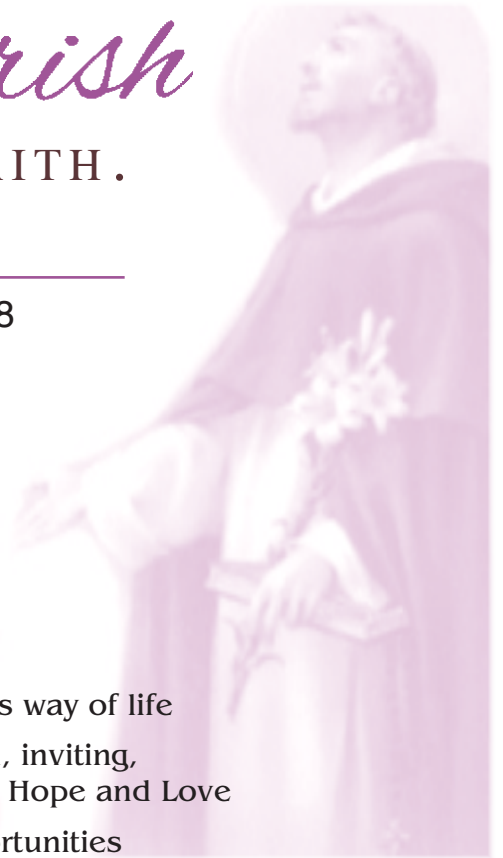

Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

RCIA RITES OF SENDING AND ELECTION

This weekend, the parish celebrates the Rite of Sending at the 9:30 a.m. Mass. In this rite, the godparents/sponsors of our candidate (**Ashley Hiett**) and catechumens (**Debbie Backscheider** and **Michaelanne Coors**) attest that they are prepared to enter the final preparation period for full participation in the Catholic Church. The parish community also has the opportunity to express our support as we "send" them to the Rite of Election assured of the parish's care and support.

The Rite of Election takes place Sunday afternoon with Archbishop Schnurr at the Cathedral of St. Peter in Chains. In this rite, the church makes its "election" or choice, that these three, along with candidates from parishes throughout the archdiocese, are in fact ready for the final preparation for receipt of the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil Mass on Saturday, March 31.

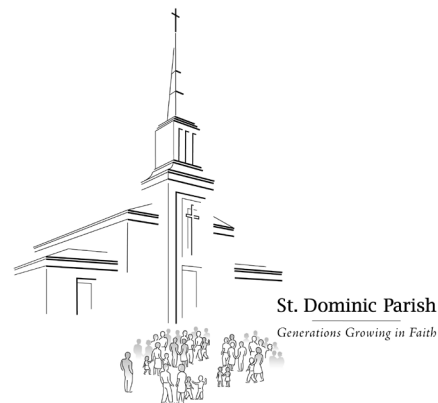
**CHRIST RENEWS HIS PARISH
