FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

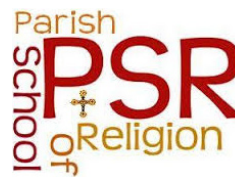

ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR)
REGISTRATION FOR 2018/2019



The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God's love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – the family, the Parish community of Faith and the larger community and world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2018/2019 school year will be online. **All registrations must be submitted by August 31.**

Access the online registration form via the Parish Website (www.stdominicedelhi.org). Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student, with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August 31.

First day of Class:

Grades 1-6: Sunday, September 9 at 10:30 a.m.

Grades 7-8: Tuesday, September 11 at 7:00 p.m.

NOTE: Grade 6 classes are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.

PSR calendars for grades 1-8 are available online in July. Complete details are found in the PSR Handbook on the parish website. If you have any questions about PSR, you can contact Theresa Eagan, Coordinator of Religious Education at 471-7741, ext. 481.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.
