For Registered Voters in the City of Cincinnati:

Last week, Mayor Cranley announced a new initiative to reinvest in our neighborhoods by upgrading and expanding our city park and trail system. For the first time in almost 90 years, citizens will have the opportunity to vote on new recreational projects throughout the city.

This program will provide sustaining funding for the Cincinnati Park Board, an award winning organization that has provided the city with world class facilities such as Smale Park, Mt. Echo Park, Ault Park and others throughout the city. The funding will be provided by a 1 million tax levy that will cost the owner of a \$100k home, approximately \$2.50 a month.

If you believe that a park's levy should be brought to the citizens of Cincinnati for a vote, please sign a ballot petition in the month of July.




