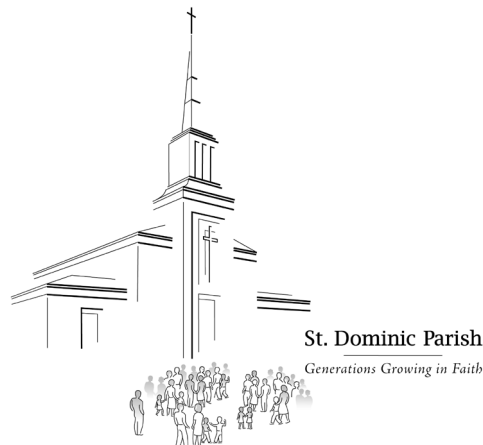
When? Friday, July 26 – 5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
