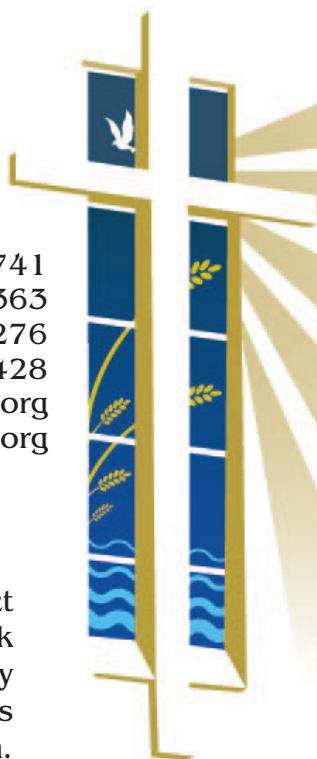

**GOD'S HOUSEKEEPERS**

**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!** Every Thursday morning after the 7:30 a.m. Mass, volunteers clean the church. Sweeping, light mopping, dusting, taking care of flowers, candles, etc., all keeps our church beautiful. When enough men and women are working together, the job is finished in 45 minutes to an hour. The more people who are helping, the faster it's finished. There is no sign-up sheet; just come help, if and when you are able. You will truly be welcomed!

**VOTIVE LIGHTS**

Envelopes for requesting a Votive Light are on the Communion railing near the Blessed Virgin altar and close to the door as you exit by the Infant of Prague statue. On the envelope, you can designate an intention. The usual donation is \$2 to cover the cost of the candle. Candles are lit on Thursday for the week. Envelopes may be put in the collection basket on the weekend or brought to the Parish Office. If you have any questions, please call 471-7741, ext. 0.

**Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

**Considering Entering the Catholic Church?**

**Sacrament of Reconciliation**

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

**Sacrament of Matrimony**

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

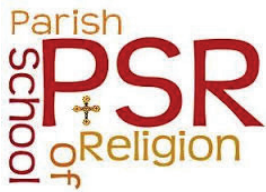

**ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR)  
2019/2020 REGISTRATION**



The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God's love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of

God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – the family, the Parish community of Faith and the larger community and world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2019/2020 school year will be online. All registrations must be submitted by August 30.

Access the online registration form via the Parish website ([www.stdominicdelhi.org](http://www.stdominicdelhi.org)). Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August 30.

**The first day of class for all grades (1-8) is Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m.**

*NOTE: Classes for grades 7/8 are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.*

PSR calendars for grades 1-8 will be available online in July. Complete details are found in the PSR Handbook on the parish website.
