## GOD'S HOUSEKEEPERS VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

## ALL PARISH VOLUNTEERS: NEW CHILD PROTECTION PLATFORM

In July 2021, the archdiocese will be moving to SafeParish as the new platform for Child Protection training and compliance. SafeParish is an



organization that specializes in training and education solutions for organizations worldwide. They have 20+ years of experience in providing child-safe environment training programs. SafeParish will continue to work with our current background check provider, Selection.com. All training and background information in your current VIRTUS account will be transferred to SafeParish. No new live training through SafeParish will be required if you have completed live child protection training through VIRTUS. Ongoing child protection training will still be required for all volunteers and employees and will consist of quarterly interactive video-based training instead of monthly bulletins. As the archdiocese moves closer to the conversion date, additional information regarding your new SafeParish account will be provided. #### Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

#### **Considering Entering the Catholic Church?**

RCIA is the process through which adults are fully initiated into the Catholic faith community. The process provides for different levels of entry. To obtain more information, call Deacon Mark Bardonaro at 471–7741.

#### **Infant Baptisms**

Attendance at a Parent Pre-Baptism Session is required. Call the Parish Office at 471-7741, ext. 0.

#### Sacrament of Reconciliation

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony**

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.


## ST. VINCENT DE PAUL BUNDLE SUNDAY This Weekend, June 26 and 27

## SUMMER BIBLE READING & REFLECTION WITH THE RCIA

We are on week four of our Summer Bible Reading & Reflection with RCIA. All parishioners are invited to participate in a parish-wide program of Bible reading and reflection with our RCIA participants and team members. Parishioners who are currently receiving the "Weekly Emails" through the "Word on Fire Institute" of Bishop Barron's will begin to receive an additional weekly email that will invite them to read certain passages from the Bible and reflect on a few guestions they will find in the email. They can share their reflection with family, friends, CRHP groups, and any group that is open to faith sharing. This can become the basis for your weekly prayer, your personal meditation, reflection or spiritual journaling – whatever works best for you to think and pray about God's Word in your life! Parishioners can even send in a comment through the weekly email. The first email was sent on June 6 and included the entire reading schedule for the summer months, so folks can plan ahead and even read ahead, if they desire. Besides using your own personal Bible, we recommend that you consider also using The Jesus Storybook Bible, especially if you have children! This is a delightful children's Bible that uses beautiful illustrations and language that even small children can understand to bring God's Word to light for them. There is a lovely richness to these simple stories and the way that all of the stories in this children's Bible point directly to God's plan of sending Jesus into the world. We encourage adults to read this story first and then read from your own Bible to perhaps see these stories from a slightly different perspective and allow the simplicity of the stories to touch your heart. This is also a way that we can all support our RCIA folks in their spiritual growth through the summer! We hope you will read and reflect along with the RCIA this summer and we will all grow closer to the Living Word of God!
