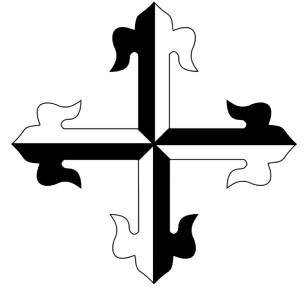

**FR. BEN'S COLUMN****Holy Trinity Sunday: What's it all about?**

If you travel around Ireland, and Britain for that matter, you cannot help being struck by the great number of ancient, ruined monuments. Of course, there are plenty of ruined castles, but by far the greater number of ruins are the monasteries, churches, and cathedrals. In Ireland, it is possible to go to the Hill of Slane and stand on the very site where St. Patrick lit the very first Easter Fire in Ireland. Great monasteries, churches, and cathedrals like Slane, Kells, Monasterboice, Glendalough, Clonmacnoise, Skellig Michael, Mellifont, and Cashel, are just a few that today lie in ruins. They were great places of prayer, hospitality, healing, pilgrimage, homes for the monks and nuns, refuges for the abandoned, the sick, and the laity, places of learning and wisdom. Most of all they were places of faith. You can look at these ruins and you can lament the passing of so much beauty and life. And yet, over a thousand years after their building, after five hundred years and more since their destruction, everything these buildings represent, everything they were built to achieve, is still alive and present in and around the same places. The faith they desired to sow and develop is still alive and well, not in the bricks, but in the hearts and the souls, in the very life of the people of Ireland. That same faith is alive and well here on the Western Front, in our homes, parishes, and most of all in our hearts.

The faith is alive, and the people have kept it alive, and that's what was essential, that the faith was passed on, sown in hearts, made real in lives, in communities, in our homes, and in our villages. The structures, the parishes and the buildings aided this work, but it was not the meaning of this work. The most important element was not a building but a people, and today those people are you. Situations, forms, and places change but we can carry on the mission. What is essential to the mission is not the place, it's the people, it's you!

Moses told his people to focus on God to "fix your hearts on God." "You must keep his statutes and commandments that I enjoin on you today, that you and your children after you may prosper, and that you may have long life on the land which the LORD, your God, is giving you forever." And just before He ascends into heaven Jesus said to His followers: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." And what did He command us: "A new commandment I give you. Love one another." Jesus also said: "Just as the Father loves me, so I have loved you. Live on in my love."

Love is the very heart of our faith, our religion, and our mission. This is what is essential, and the family is the most important school of love, the most important community of faith. The great Latin chant put it well: "Ubi caritas et amor, Deus ibi est." "Where charity and love are, God is there." The Holy Trinity is the home of a family of love. Love expresses what that family is about. Our families are to be a school of love. Family is the place where we learn to love. To sow love in the heart is to proclaim the very essence, the core, of the Gospel. When love dwells in a family God is present there.

Thank you to all those who have already completed the parish census. All registered parish families who have not yet completed the census should have received a second letter and/or email about updating their information. Registration and updating your parish information is important and necessary for receiving sacraments (weddings, baptisms, funerals, etc.), as well as priority for school registration. Likewise, if you need a letter of suitability attesting to your membership to be a godparent/sponsor, we can only complete this form if you are a registered member. We ask that you complete this census as soon as possible. Online is the fastest, easiest way, but there are other options outlined in the letter if you prefer not to do it online.
