#### Sacrament of Reconciliation

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony**

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.


## PARKING FOR 7:30 A.M. MASSGOERS ON SCHOOL DAYS!

You can continue to park where you do in the upper parking lot. There will be some spaces marked off by cones for "No Parking". Parking over by Vitt, Stermer and Anderson is open against the back, but you might have trouble getting out after Mass. When you leave Mass, be careful getting to your car as school cars will be coming from the direction of the school entrance, where the children will be having their temperatures checked in their cars. When you exit on to Delhi Pike, you will only be able to turn right! Right turn only between 7:30 and 8:30 a.m. on school days!

Churchgoers who normally park in the lower lot will have to park somewhere else as the Before and After School parents will be dropping off their children in O'Conner Hall.
