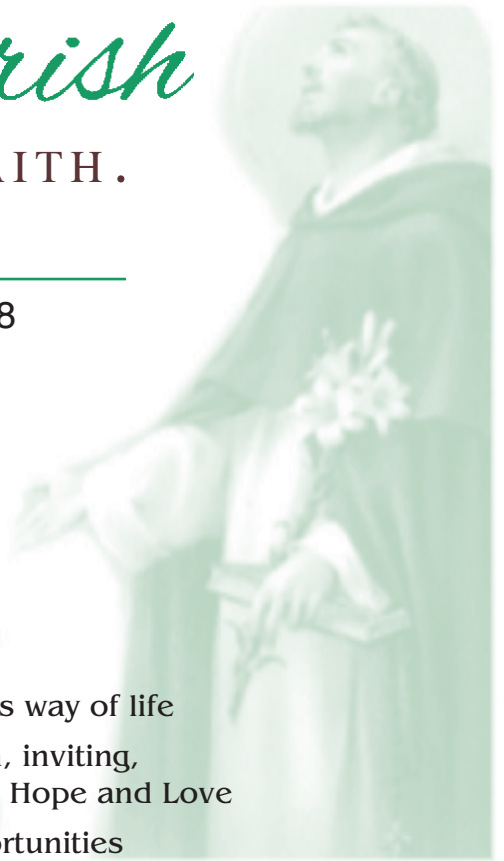
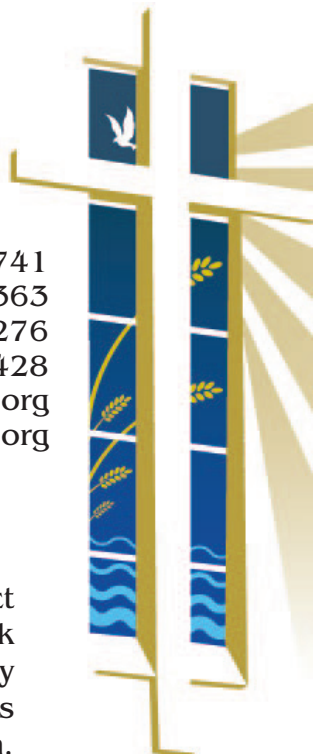

**ST. DOMINIC-DELHI KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS**

The St. Dominic-Delhi Knights of Columbus are holding a Speaker's Program on Tuesday, November 19 beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Faith Sharing Room. Kathy Williams, manager of the USO Lounges at the Greater Cincinnati Airport, will be giving a presentation on the mission and works of the USO in our area. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

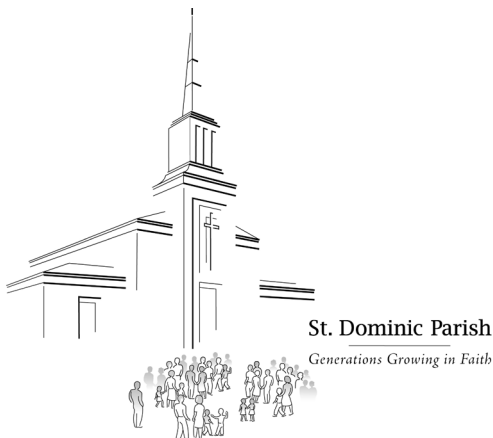
