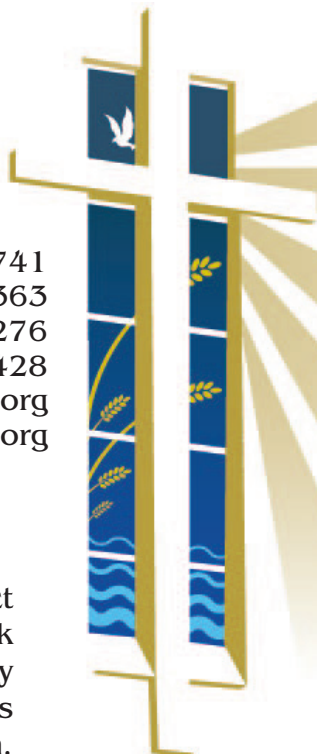

Sacrament of Matrimony

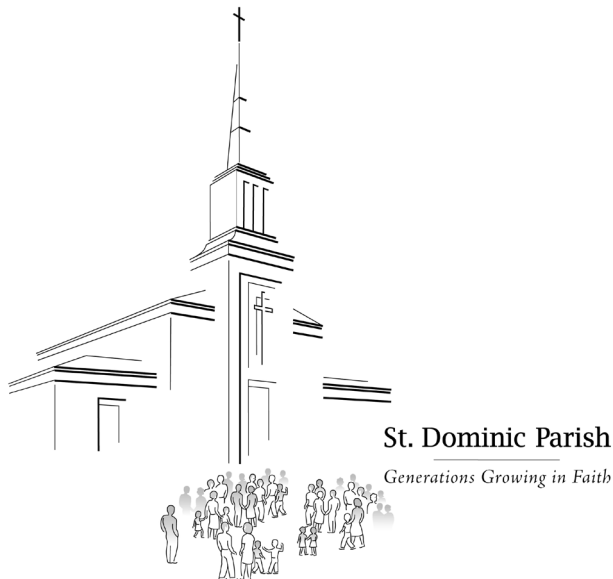

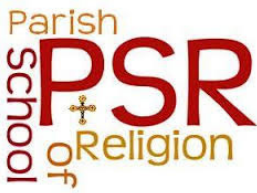
