

LITTLE SISTERS OF THE POOR COLLECTION Collection Weekend January 30 & 31



ST. DOMINIC NEWS

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR – The application process for applying for financial assistance for the 2021-2022 school year is now open. If you have a high school student next year, and you have applied for assistance through FACTS, you do not have to complete the application for your St. Dominic student, as long as you have selected St. Dominic as one of your schools. PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU HAVE SELECTED ST. DOMINIC AS ONE OF YOUR

SCHOOLS.

To begin the application process, go to: www.factsmgt.com. In the upper left corner of the page, click on "Parent Log In". If you applied for assistance last year (2020-2021), your login credentials will be the same. If you are utilizing FACTS for tuition payment processing for this current school year, your login credentials are the same. Click on the link, "Apply for Financial Aid." The instructions for completing the application are relatively intuitive, however, if you experience any issues, please contact FACTS at 1-866-412-4637.

Awards will first be granted through the Catholic Education Foundation (The Archdiocese of Cincinnati's One Faith One Hope One Love Campaign). CEF awards will be announced in February 2021. St. Dominic will announce Parish awards in the Spring of 2021. The deadline to apply for assistance is January 31, 2021 for CEF and St. Dominic Parish Awards. No exceptions can be made! You will need your 2019 tax return information. You will also have to upload pages 1 & 2 from your 2019 tax return as well as copies of any 2019 W-2's.

STATEMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS – If you wish to receive a statement of your contributions for 2020, please drop the PINK card from the back of your 2020 envelopes in the collection on Sunday or bring it to the Parish Office. You can also contact the Parish Office at 471-7741, ext. 0 or parishoffice@stdominicdelhi.org to request a statement. Statements will begin to be mailed out after all postings are finished for 2020.


