Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Last Sunday at the 11:30 a.m. Mass, Kurt Ruffing, the principal of Elder High School, surprised Bob Sanker with an honorary high school diploma! Bob attended Elder during the 1951-1952 school year. His father passed away and he had to withdraw from Elder to work at the tavern his father owned. He did this to support his mother and siblings. He was unable to complete his high school education, something he regrets to this day. Bob has always been a highly-respected member of the Delhi Community. He served with the Delhi Township Fire Department for 43 years, many of those years as assistant fire chief. He owned and operated Sanker's gas station for many years with honesty and generosity. Here at St. Dominic, we recognize him as our "living saint!" He served as president of the St. Vincent de Paul Society for approximately 25 years. Bob was the recipient of the Dorothy Stang Award in 2019 given out by the Archdiocese, being recognized for modeling a missionary spirit of loving service to those in need. If anyone has been about "Altiora," "the Higher Things," it has been Bob Sanker. Congratulations, Bob!




FR. JIM'S 80TH BIRTHDAY


