#### Lenten Regulations for Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, February 22 and Good Friday, April 7, are days of abstinence from meat and days of fast (that is, limited to a single full meal). Regarding Good Friday, the teaching of the Second Vatican Council should be recalled:


Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with an uplifted and clear mind. (*Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110*)

The other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years of age and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (Canons 97 and 1252).

Regarding the obligatory days listed above, there are frequent questions about the degree of seriousness of the matter. The teaching of the Holy Father may be simply paraphrased: The obligation to do penance is a serious one; the obligation to observe, or "substantially," the penitential days specified by the Church is also serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe an individual day of penance is not considered serious. People should seek to do more, rather than less. Fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimum response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion.

### Bible Study with Fr. Jim and Fr. Chris

Join Fr. Jim and Fr. Chris during Lent as they study Bishop Robert Barron's *Seven Last Words*. The sessions will be on four Tuesdays beginning on February 28 at 7:00 p.m. in O'Connor Hall. Each session will last about an hour. Fr. Chris will be recording each session and we will send it out to all those on our *Word on Fire* email list each week.

Come spend an hour in prayer with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Join us on Monday, March 13 at 7:00 p.m. in church for Eucharistic Adoration and Holy Hour with Exposition and Benediction. Fr. Jim and Fr. Chris will also be hearing Confessions during this time.

#### Meet Our Newest St. Dominic School Team Member: Kiawe!

In December, St. Dominic School welcomed a facility dog named Bree into school. While Bree was very sweet and already started working her magic with the students, she had one very bad manner. She barked. A lot. And it was loud. The purpose of a facility dog is to enhance school life, not to detract from the educational atmosphere. Bree's barking was just too disruptive. Bree has been sent back to

Circle Tail, where she will receive more training and then be placed in a different facility. We now have a new dog with us. Her name is Kiawe. We are confident the children will come to love her as much as they did Bree. Kiawe is a two-year-old Lab/Retriever Mix.

Facility Dogs are specially trained to provide physical, social, cognitive, or emotional assistance to Community members in schools/classrooms, courthouses, sober living homes, funeral homes, hospice centers, and more.

Kiawe is not a pet; she is a working dog trained to conduct herself by recognizing the emotional state or needs of humans. Circle Tail trains and places facility dogs in various school systems in the Greater Cincinnati area. These dogs have gone through at least a year of specialty training and have the capacity to assist and participate in the school system to help support children's physical, emotional, and cognitive needs. Kiawe's main job is to support students who may be struggling. However, she can assist in many ways throughout the day. Kiawe will maintain a set working schedule, primarily comforting and assisting students who are referred to the Counselor, Social Worker, or Nurse. Kiawe will also have time to visit classrooms, time to sit and be read to by younger students, and time to visit older students to see how their day is going.

Research has shown that a facility dog can be beneficial in several ways, including, but not limited to:

- can improve self-esteem, acceptance from others and lifts mood, often provoking laughter and fun;
- can help break down many of the barriers that naturally exist between people who are meeting for the first time. Students meeting with the principal may greatly benefit from this interaction;
- can assist when a crisis occurs; and
- can reduce anxiety and stress and provide unconditional acceptance.
