Sacrament of Matrimony

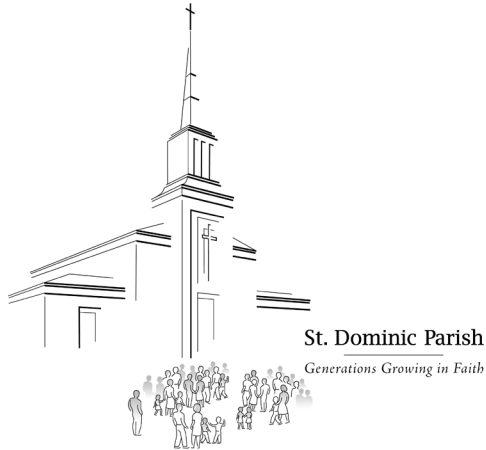

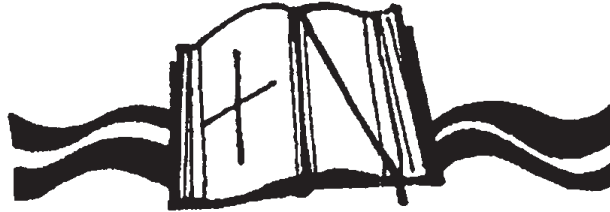
