Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.


#### LAS VEGAS NIGHT AND MAJOR AWARD

\$1,000.00 WELCOME SCHOLARSHIPS - The Catholic Education Foundation for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati is excited to offer a limited number of Welcome Scholarships to pre-School or Kindergarten students who are the first of their family to attend a Catholic school. Qualifying Criteria: The applicant's child(ren) must be attending preschool or Kindergarten AND be the first in their family to attend a Catholic School. The applicant must be the parent or legal guardian of the child(ren). The family must complete a Catholic Education Foundation Application, as well as a FACTS Grant and Aid Application, in order to be considered for this scholarship. This scholarship can be applied at any Catholic elementary school recognized by the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. Funds can only be used for tuition, not student or activity fees. The family will not be eligible to receive this assistance if an Ohio EdChoice or Jon Peterson Scholarship covers the entire tuition amount. Application Process: The application period opened January 24, 2022 and will remain open as funds allow. A link to the application, as well as FACTS Grant and Aid, can be found at CatholicBestChoice.org. Applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. The Catholic Education Foundation will award up to \$1,000.00 per qualifying child. The parent or guardian will be notified of the awarding decision in mid-February, 2022. #### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

The application process for applying for financial assistance for the 2022-2023 school year is now open. If you have a high school student next year and you have applied for assistance through FACTS, you do not have to complete the application for your St. Dominic student, as long as you have selected St. Dominic as one of your schools. PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU HAVE SELECTED ST. DOMINIC AS ONE OF YOUR SCHOOLS.

To begin the application process, go to www.factsmgt.com. In the upper-left corner of the page, click on "Parent Log In." If you applied for assistance last year, 2021-2022, your login credentials will be the same. If you are utilizing FACTS for tuition payment processing for this current school year, your login credentials are the same. Click on the link, "Apply for Financial Aid." The instructions for completing the application are relatively intuitive, however if you experience any issues, please contact FACTS at 866-412-4637.

Awards will first be granted through the Catholic Education Foundation (The Archdiocese of Cincinnati's One Faith, One Hope, One Love Campaign). CEF awards will be announced in February, 2022. St. Dominic will announce Parish awards in the Spring of 2022.

The deadline to apply for assistance is February 6, 2022 for CEF and St. Dominic Parish Awards. No exceptions can be made! You will need your 2020 tax return information. You will also have to upload pages 1 and 2 from your 2020 tax return, as well as copies of any 2020 W-2s.
