One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) 2020/2021 REGISTRATION



The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God's love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – the family, the Parish community of Faith and the larger community and world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

The first day of class for all grades (1-8) is Sunday, September 13 at 10:30 a.m.

NOTE: PSR for all grades will be held in the classrooms/ library under the church. The rooms will be sanitized each week before and after PSR meets. We are also working to come up with a plan that covers all the Covid guidelines.

Registration for the 2020/2021 school year is online and will be available for you to access in a few couple of weeks. Please keep watching the bulletin for registration information.


ST. DOMINIC-DELHI KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS


