#### ST. DOMINIC – DELHI KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

In July of 2018, St. Dominic-Delhi Knights of Columbus purchased for the parish a kiosk with booklets from the "Building the Domestic Church" series from the Catholic Information Service provided by the national council. 
> Platinum Level Gift of \$3,250 Sponsors a student for an entire school year
