St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society

Thank You to all the parishioners of St. Dominic. Because of your generous donations, from April through June of 2018, the St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society helped 69 families, made up of 228 adults and children, in our service area which includes Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside.

St. Vincent de Paul Society's total receipts for the second quarter of 2018 were \$11,536.50 from the poor box collections, the parishioner donations, the schoolchildren, and the member donations. Parishioners donated \$1,804.00 by using the St. Vincent de Paul envelopes included with the St. Dominic Parish envelopes. We received a nice donation from St. Vincent de Paul Parish because they do not have an SVdP Society and our St. Dominic's SVdP Society serves their clients in Sedamsville and Riverside.

Bill Rasmussen, who previously was very active with the St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society, died a couple of months ago, but his legacy to the St. Dominic SVdP Society continues because there have been many, many donations to the St. Dominic SVdP Society in Bill's memory. We thank Cathy, Bill's wife, for requesting that donations be made to the St. Dominic's SVdP in Bill's memory. St. Dominic's SVdP has been able to help many needy families because of Cathy's thoughtfulness and the many generous friends who remember what Bill stood for and followed his example.

As always, we thank the St. Dominic School children for all the food that they donated each month to help us feed our neighbors.

Our St. Vincent de Paul Society paid out \$12,404.44 to aid our neighbors during the months of April through June 2018. The breakdown is as follows:

Requirements for Those Volunteering with Children

As a reminder, all volunteers are required to attend one VIRTUS live training session. You can attend this training at any location at a date/time that works best for you. Find training locations, registration details and steps to create your VIRTUS user account at www.VIRTUS.org. Click on training, then live training to see a list of all scheduled live training sessions.

The second requirement for volunteers is to complete an online background check request. Payment for this is by credit card or "token" at the time of your online request. Contact the organization for which you volunteer to get information on obtaining a token for payment. To initiate the online background check, sign in to your VIRTUS.org user account, click the "Toolbox" tab then click the selection.com background check link. St. Dominic Parish School of Religion (PSR) Registration For 2018/2019

The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God's love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – the family, the Parish community of Faith and the larger community and world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2018/2019 school year is online. All registrations must be submitted by August 31.

Access the online registration form via the Parish Website (www.stdominicdelhi.org). Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August. 31.

First day of Class:

Grades 1 - 6: Sunday, September 9 at 10:30 a.m.

Grades 7 - 8: Tuesday, September 11 at 7:00 p.m.

NOTE: Grade 6 classes are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.
