The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Infant Baptisms

Attendance at a Parent Pre-Baptism Session is required. Call the Parish Office at 471-7741, ext. 0.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Communion for the Sick and Homebound

Please call the Parish Office to request this service.

Every Thursday morning after the 7:30 a.m. Mass, volunteers clean the church. Sweeping, light mopping, dusting, taking care of flowers, candles, etc., all keeps our church beautiful. When enough men and women are working together, the job is finished in 45 minutes to an hour. The more people who are helping, the faster it's finished. There is no sign-up sheet; just come help, if and when you are able. You will truly be welcomed!



SUMMER BIBLE READING & REFLECTION WITH THE RCIA

We are on week five of our Summer Bible Reading & Reflection with RCIA. All parishioners are invited to participate in a parishwide program of Bible reading and reflection with our RCIA participants and team members. Parishioners who are currently receiving the "Weekly Emails" through the "Word on Fire Institute" of Bishop Barron's should be receiving an additional weekly email that will invite them to read certain passages from the Bible and reflect on a few questions they will find in the email.

The first email was sent on June 6 and included the entire reading schedule for the summer months so folks can plan ahead and even read ahead if they desire. Besides using your own personal Bible, we recommend that you consider also using *The Jesus Storybook Bible*, especially if you have children! This is a delightful children's Bible, that uses beautiful illustrations and language that even small children can understand to bring God's Word to light for them. There is a lovely richness to these simple stories and the way that all of the stories in this children's Bible point directly to God's plan of sending Jesus into the world. This is also a way that we can all support our RCIA folks in their spiritual growth through the summer! We hope you will read and reflect along with the RCIA this summer and we will all grow closer to the living Word of God!


