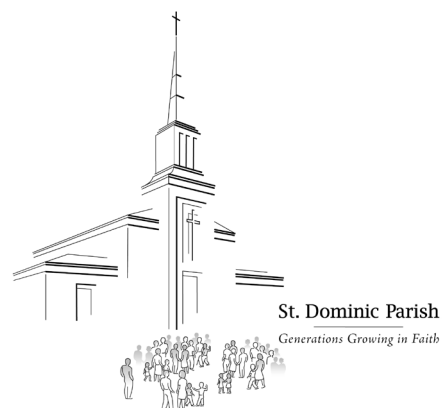

### PARENTAL PREPARATION FOR THEIR INFANT'S BAPTISM
