St. Dominic Conference St. Vincent de Paul Society

St. Dominic's SVdP has a new president, Christelle Middendorf, who succeeded Gary Ott, whose term was completed. Christelle is already providing great leadership and encouragement.

St. Dominic's SVdP tries to assist ALL who request our help and live in our area which includes all of St. Dominic Parish plus Sedamsville and Riverside from Steiner to Anderson Ferry.

Our receipts from January 1, 2023 through March 31, 2023 were \$34,483.89. Our total expenses for the same period were also significant at \$29,210.62. In the first quarter of 2023, we provided aid 101 times to 273 individuals. The breakdown of the "direct aid" that we gave is as follows:

Utility Bills (Duke Energy and GCWW)	\$ 6,507.55
Food and Kroger Gift Cards	\$ 3,147.87
Rent & Mortgage Assistance	\$ 9,052.45
"Twinning Help" to 5 neighboring SVdP Conferences	\$ 10,400.00
Bank Checks and Stamps	\$ 102.75

In addition to this "direct aid," St. Dominic's SVdP provided clothing/household and furniture and bed vouchers from the SVdP Thrift Stores worth more than \$7,050.00.

Since we had some extremely generous donations in the first quarter, and we believe that the donors meant for the funds to be used, we chose to share \$10,000 of those donations with five (5) other westside parishes who were not so blessed, but still had great need. We trust that donors will continue to enable St. Dominic's SVdP to help our needy neighbors in the future.

The members of St. Dominic's SVdP spent over 352 hours talking to and counseling our neighbors in need, taking food to them and providing vouchers to them. We drove over 811 miles helping our neighbors. We bought the food and gift cards and stocked the pantry so we could provide food for our hungry neighbors. We wrote and mailed checks for rent/mortgage and utilities. We keep busy at this volunteer job.
