COLLECTION FOR MILITARY SERVICES

On November 9/10, we will take up the collection to aid the work of the Archdiocese for Military Services, USA (AMS). This special collection began in 2013 at the request of the Most Reverend Timothy Broglio, Archbishop for Military Services and it happens only once every three years. The AMS receives no funding from the U.S. Government or the U.S. Military, has no parishes for a weekly in-pew collection, and must rely principally on private donations to fund their operating budget. The AMS is responsible for providing the full range of pastoral ministries available in all other U.S. diocese to those serving in the United States Armed Services.

Thank You to all the parishioners of St Dominic.

Because of your generous donations, from July through September 2019, the St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Dominic helped 67 families, made up of 225 adults and children, in our service area which includes Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside.

Remember that the St. Dominic SVdP Conference has NO overhead, personnel or office expenses.

Every cent that is donated to the St. Dominic SVdP is used to help our neighbors. St. Dominic SVdP's total receipts for the third quarter of 2019 were \$9,485.00 from the poor box collections, the parishioner donations, the schoolchildren, and the member donations. Parishioners donated \$6,077.00 by using the St. Vincent de Paul envelopes included with the St. Dominic Parish envelopes. SVdP thanks all the people who so generously remembered their friends and loved ones by donating to SVdP.

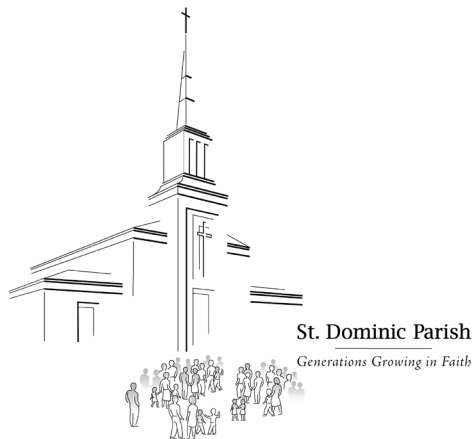
As always, we thank the St. Dominic School children for all the food and other items that they donated to help us with our neighbors. The toilet paper, toiletries and cleaning products including laundry and dish detergent are especially welcome as our neighbors who need help cannot use Food Stamps to get these items.

Because there were funds left over from previous quarters, the **St. Dominic SVdP was able to provide \$10,414 in aid to our neighbors during the months of July through September of 2019.** The breakdown is as follows:
