Lenten Regulations for Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, February 14 and Good Friday, March 29, are days of abstinence from meat and days of fast (that is, limited to a single full meal). Regarding Good Friday, the teaching of the Second Vatican Council should be recalled:

Let the paschal fast be kept sacred. Let it be celebrated everywhere on Good Friday and, where possible, prolonged throughout Holy Saturday, so that the joys of the Sunday of the Resurrection may be attained with an uplifted and clear mind. (*Constitution on the Liturgy, No. 110*)

The other Fridays of the season of Lent are days of abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years of age and older. The law of fasting binds all Catholics from their 18th birthday until their 59th birthday (Canons 97 and 1252).

Regarding the obligatory days listed above, there are frequent questions about the degree of seriousness of the matter. The teaching of the Holy Father may be simply paraphrased: the obligation to do penance is a serious one; the obligation to observe, or "substantially," the penitential days specified by the Church is also serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe an individual day of penance is not considered serious. People should seek to do more, rather than less. Fast and abstinence on the days prescribed should be considered a minimum response to the Lord's call to penance and conversion.

Bible Study with Fr. Jim and Fr. Chris

Join Fr. Jim and Fr. Chris during Lent as they study the Gospel of Mark (Part 2). This is a continuation of the Fall Bible Study, but you did not have to attend in the fall to join during Lent. The sessions will be on four consecutive Tuesdays beginning on February 27 at 7:00 p.m. in O'Connor Hall. If you attended in the Fall and picked up the book for Part 2, you do not need to register. If you did not attend in the Fall or did not pick up a book, please call the Parish Office at 513-471-7741, ext. 0. Fr. Chris will be recording each session, and we will send it out to all those on our Word on Fire email list each week.

Thank you and Happy New Year from St. Vincent de Paul, St. Dominic Conference. 2023 was a year of rising challenges to meet the increased needs of our neighbors. We are extremely grateful for all your support this past year – your prayers, your food donations, and your financial contributions! Our Conference members (Vincentians) were busy; we were able to offer support to many neighbors in need. In October/November/December, we made 162 home/phone visits, which assisted 444 people. Our top three expenses during this time frame were – rent: \$9,251.50, utilities: \$8,080.58 and food: \$3,054.51. We also offered other assistance – budgeting advice, local food pantry information, resource connections (government agencies, library resources, etc.). So, you can see, we really rely on your support!

We had several Vincentians with a lot of longevity retire in 2023. We are thankful for the path they set forward for us, for their insight and wisdom and their countless hours of giving back to our parish and community. Looking forward, we ask you to keep us in your prayers in 2024; please pray that we have the resources, knowledge, energy, compassion, and discernment needed to help our neighbors as God thinks we should.
