THE THREE FACETS OF TOTAL STEWARDSHIP

Traditional literature on stewardship uses three categories: time, talent and treasure. However, we at St. Dominic Parish have chosen to view total stewardship in a slightly different manner. We believe that our total stewardship focus should not only be on giving of our time and talent and treasures, but needs to include taking time to communicate with the Lord, thus, Total Stewardship must include the facets of Prayer, Ministry and Treasures.

STEWARDSHIP OF PRAYER

This facet of stewardship suggests that we COMMIT some time each day in communication with God, whether it be in individual prayer or prayer with others, as a part of our Family or Parish Community.

STEWARDSHIP OF MINISTRY

The premise of this facet is that Everyone, me and you, has something to give. And not only that we all have something to give, but we want to give of our time and talent to others – to our Families, to our Neighbors, to our Parish Family, to our Delhi Community, to the World.

STEWARDSHIP OF TREASURE

Sacrificial giving is at the heart of this facet of Total Stewardship.
