 - a) Mark Goins, Joe Kruessel, Michael Stenger, Jessica Remmel, Tobie Delaney
 - b) Postpone election to Sunday before Labor Day (Aug 29/30), approved by unanimous consent
- 5) First Communion (and Graduation?) Update Plans? What can we do to help?
 - a) Considering through May 17 (end of PSR school year) or postpone to fall. Also considering letting families choose a weekend they like, to celebrate during mass.
 - b) Recommend choice of any of three weekends in summer. Need to coordinate with parish office for presider schedule to ensure one of our clergy is celebrating.
- 6) Principal's Update What Support/Plans are in place? What can we do to help?
 - a) Graduation
 - i) Discussing with parish and school leadership options if formal ceremony not possible by end of school year.
 - ii) Although many standardized tests are being cancelled, plan to postpone AIR test for math achievement/placement. Bill to work with Mrs Teepen and Dr Romanello to coordinate.
 - iii) Proposed some sort of tribute from other grades, maybe through Blackhawk Buddies.
 - b) 17 people furloughed in parish & school
 - c) Working with St Vincent de Paul to get food to school families in need
 - d) Teachers have assembled a video reciting St Dominic unity prayer, will post on school social media
 - e) ~88% return registration for 2020-21, 375 students, plus some new families
 - f) Two positions open: 8th grade and computer, interviewing remotely
 - g) Mr Cavanaugh and Dr Romanello actively reaching out to students/families who are struggling with work. Will also be reaching out to families who haven't turned in work or responded to teacher inquiries.
 - h) Advise compiling teacher feedback on what is and is not working, use to improve current teaching and future preparedness.

- i) Asking for information on families who might be financially struggling. Resources are available from St Vincent de Paul, other parish resources.
- j) Administration is considering communication to address questions about tuition reimbursement.

7) PTO

- a) Will be offering reimbursement for hot lunch prepays
- b) Walkathon will not be a fundraiser this year. If event is held (i.e., if school is back in session), will be paid for by PTO
