For your peace of mind, know that we are professionally cleaning and sanitizing the church pews and Gathering Place before, during and after the weekend Masses. Come Holy Spirit and fill the hearts of your faithful and renew the face of the earth!

# GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING PUBLIC MASS AT ST. DOMINIC

As of Pentecost Sunday, we are resuming our regular Mass schedule. Below are the guidelines for returning to public Mass from Fr. Jim, Fr. Chris, Deacon Mark, and the Parish Staff.

First, remember that you are dispensed from your Sunday obligation to attend Mass. Your desire to participate in Mass could be fulfilled on any day of the week. We are working on getting the Sunday Mass recorded from church. We are trusting that no one who is sick is coming to Mass.

On the side of church facing Delhi Pike, only the center doors will be open. The side doors are for exit only. Both doors on the parking lot side of church will be open.

When you arrive at Mass, we expect you to be wearing a mask. Upon entering, sanitize your hands from the containers provided and pick up a worship aid. (There will be no hymnals or missalettes.)

Every other pew will be roped off. In the pew be sure to maintain a six-foot distance between your household members and any others. Look to the left and the right. No physical contact at the Our Father and Sign of Peace.

At Communion, the Eucharistic Ministers will be wearing a mask. There will only be Eucharist distributed in the hand without contact. No Communion on the tongue. There will be no cups. When you are in line, we expect you to be wearing a mask and maintaining a six-foot distance to the person in front of you. Receive the host in your left hand, take it with your right hand, and with your left hand pull down your mask so you can consume the host, and then pull the face mask up for your return to the pew.

On leaving church be sure to sanitize your hands and bring your worship aids to discard in the trash cans. We do not reuse them at the next Mass.

Please be charitable as we deal with this situation as a parish family. If you come to church and there is no room in keeping physical distance, do not endanger your health or someone else's by crowding into a pew. The loving thing to do is leave, perhaps come back to another Mass, or during the week, remembering that you are dispensed from the obligation.

Confessions will resume after Saturday's 8:15 a.m. Mass on May 30th. They will take place in the Cry Room. Wait in the center aisle in the rear of church if the door is closed. If it is open, come in. All Confessions will be anonymous. Fr. Chris and I would prefer that you wear a mask for Confession.

#### **Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick**

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

#### **Considering Entering the Catholic Church?**

RCIA is the process through which adults are fully initiated into the Catholic faith community. The process provides for different levels of entry. To obtain more information, call Deacon Mark Bardonaro at 471–7741.

#### **Infant Baptisms**

Attendance at a Parent Pre-Baptism Session is required. Call the Parish Office at 471-7741, ext. 0.

#### **Sacrament of Reconciliation**

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

#### **Sacrament of Matrimony**

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

#### **Communion for the Sick and Homebound**

Please call the Parish Office to request this service.


