Palm Sunday, on April 2, begins the most sacred week of our liturgical year. The Triduum is at the very heart of our Holy Week gatherings. The word is from Latin, and it means "three days." On Holy Thursday, we celebrate Jesus' gift of the Eucharist to us. On Good Friday, we celebrate Jesus' gift of His life for our salvation. At the Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday, we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ and our destiny of sharing in God's life for all eternity.

If some of you who get this report each month have not been to St. Dominic in a while, please consider this an invitation to join us for these three special days. The Spirit of God has been transforming our parish community at each Sunday Eucharist. There are marvelous signs of parishioners growing in the Lord. We invite you to be a part of that. If you have been thinking "I have to get back to Church," trust that that very thought is already the activity and movement of God within you.

Please note the schedule for our Holy Week services. The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening begins at 7:00 p.m. Our Good Friday Celebration of the Lord's Passion is at Noon and 7:00 p.m. The Easter Vigil is on Saturday evening beginning at 8:30 p.m. This is the high point of our Liturgical Year and our most important gathering as a St. Dominic Parish community. We celebrate it well. Come and be lifted up!

On Easter Sunday, our Masses are at 7:30, 9:30, and 11:30 a.m. There is no 7:00 p.m. Mass.

My hope and prayer this Holy Week is that you will respond with gratitude to the God who gives you the time of your life. And may that gratitude find expression in your giving back to God some of your prime time on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter.

May the Holy Week liturgies fill your hearts with love and gratitude for the salvation that is ours because of Jesus Christ and His Passion, death, and Resurrection! And may you all have a Happy Easter!

Family Of Parishes

In July 2022, we introduced you to the priests that will be ministering to the Mary, Queen of All Saints family of parishes. Over the last several months, we have shared a little bit of the history of the parishes that make up our family of parishes. We have covered all but St. Vincent de Paul and our own St. Dominic. This month, we feature St. Vincent de Paul Parish.

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL PARISH

Named for the French priest and founded in 1861, St. Vincent de Paul Parish was originally located in Sedamsville on Delhi Avenue, below Fairbanks. Housed in a small wooden frame building, it served the large number of Irish immigrants of the area. Rather than walk over a mile to St. Michael Church, the local German immigrants soon joined them. Eventually, the Germans decided to establish their own parish, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, just down the street.

By 1923, it was decided more room was needed and land was purchased on River Road in Riverside. The rectory, a large stone house built in the 1880s, served as the rectory, convent, school, and chapel. A new one-story church building was built and in use by 1926. In 1937, a devastating flood of the Ohio River reached into the Church.

This location also served as the National Shrine of St. Christopher. Before the interstates, US 50 served as a major east-west route across the country. Automobiles would stop and people would knock on the door of the rectory so a priest could go to the shrine, bless their car, and present them with a St. Christopher medal to protect them and their car. The marble statue, imported from Italy, was vandalized in 1997 and replaced by a bronze statue of St. Vincent de Paul.

In 2011, we celebrated our Sesquicentennial with 150 years of service to God's Church and the community. St. Vincent de Paul continues to be a vibrant parish that serves hundreds of worshippers attending the four weekend Masses.

A Perfect Gift

Mother's Day and Father's Day are coming soon! Consider purchasing a Gathering Place paver for your mother, father, grandparent, or spouse to let them know how cherished they are.

Order forms are available in the racks at the doors of church, or you can download a form from the parish website by clicking on *Ministries/General Parish Ministries/Gathering Place Walkway*. Bricks and Pavers can also be ordered online by going to our website by clicking on the green *Online Giving* button on the left hand side, scroll until you find *Gathering Place Walkway*. You can also stop in the Parish Office to order a paver.

The 4 x 8 bricks allow 3 lines with 13 characters per line and cost \$40.00.

The 8 x 8 pavers allow up to 6 lines with 13 characters per line and cost \$75.00.

The bricks are ordered twice a year, once in January and once in July.
