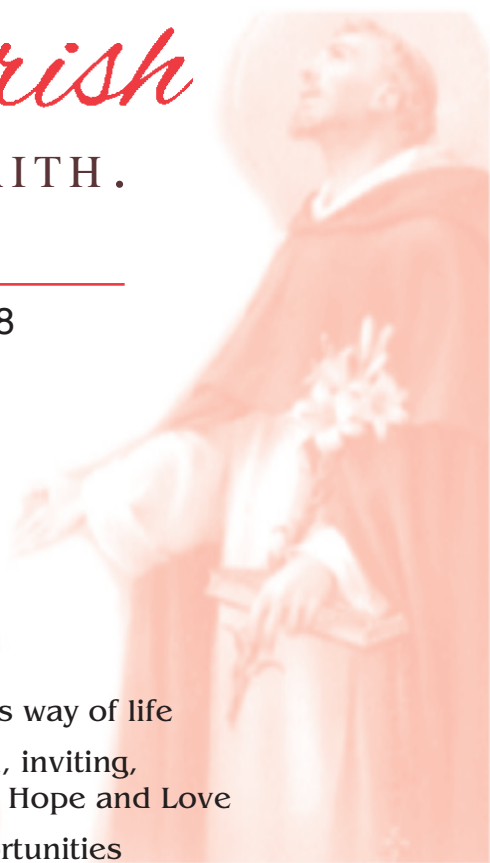

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Last Saturday, we celebrated the funeral Mass for Harry Groen. We lost a faithful follower of Jesus, a leader of this parish community, and a friend. Christopher Wrenn was the architect and builder of the famous St. Paul's Cathedral in London. He is buried in the cathedral. His epitaph reads: "If you seek my monument, look around you!" If you seek a monument to Harry Groen, look around you the next time you come to church. Harry led the project to renovate the church... new floor, stained glass windows, refurbished pews. He chaired the project to build the parish center and the gathering place, and to raise the funds to pay for it. During the construction, Harry was up at church every day making sure that the construction company was doing it right. Most recently, he supervised the replacement of our front steps to church. Reminders of Harry Groen's love and service to us all are all around us. In these past few years, Harry took great delight in learning how to serve early Mass. For me that was a symbol of Harry's life...serving others! Pastors have come and gone here at St. Dominic, but through the years, Harry Groen has been a constant and stable lay leader in the parish. Thank you, Harry! We will miss you!

2019 ANNUAL MISSION COOPERATION IS COMING

On the weekend of June 15/16, Fr. Peter Marsalek from the Society of Our Lady of the Most Holy Trinity (SOLT) will give a mission appeal at our parish. Serving in twelve countries including the United States, SOLT Missionaries bring hope and the love of Jesus and Mary to people living in impoverished conditions. They serve migrant farm workers, refugees, Native Americans, orphans, the elderly, families and those undergoing drug rehabilitation.

SOLT missionaries serve in parishes and schools giving the sacraments and teaching catechism in remote areas. They also care for the needs of the poor through community and family development projects such as clean water, food and medical care. Your generosity makes it possible for these missionaries to bring Christ to the poor.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

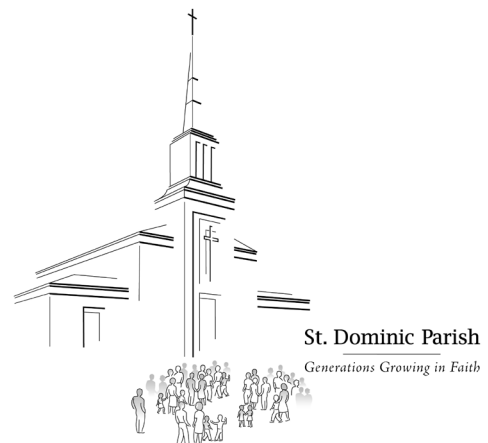
