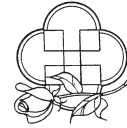

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

This will be a powerful evening of prayer, meditation and music that is sure to touch the soul on your Lenten journey.

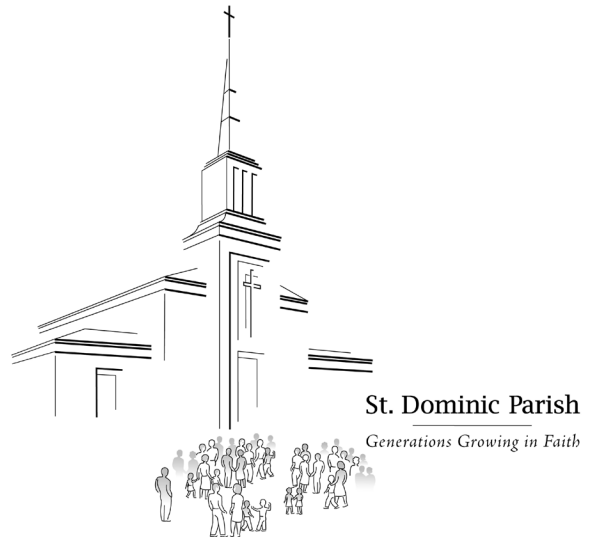


ST. DOMINIC VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
