Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Here at St. Dominic, we are building our own "Wailing Wall" on the walls of the Gathering Place. Our schoolchildren will be adding their prayers of sorrow to this wall by writing them down on "stones" of paper. Their prayers will become the foundation of our wall. You are invited to join your prayers with the prayers of the parish. In the Gathering Place there are paper "stones" for you to write your prayer on; you can then place it in the box for Wailing Wall Stones. (We are doing it this way to maintain Covid-19 protocol and allow anonymity for everyone.) These stones will be added throughout Lent, and the paper stones will become the "kindling" for the fire at our Easter Vigil which will become the Light of Christ!
