ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY ST. DOMINIC CONFERENCE QUARTERLY REPORT

Thanks to the members of St. Dominic Parish, since 1951 St. Vincent de Paul Society has been at the heart of St. Dominic's charitable giving. For over sixty-eight (68) years the people of this parish have helped their neighbors in need with their donations to SVdP. For the past few years, our most frequent calls have been for food. We don't have an open food pantry like St. William, the Anderson Ferry Food Pantry or the food pantry at Holy Family, but we take food to families in emergency situations. We serve neighbors in our service area which includes Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside.

Remember that St. Dominic's SVdP Conference has NO overhead, personnel or office expenses. Every cent that is donated to St. Dominic's SVdP is used to help our neighbors. If you wish to make a donation "In Honor of" or "In Memory of" someone, there are envelopes and donation cards at all the entrances to St. Dominic Church as well as at the Vitt, Stermer & Anderson Funeral Home. The gift will be acknowledged by a handwritten note to the recipient.

St. Dominic SVdP's total receipts for the fourth quarter of 2019 were \$18,589.60 from the poor box collections, the parishioner donations, the schoolchildren, and member donations. As always, we thank the St. Dominic School children for all the food that they donate each month to help us feed our neighbors.

Because of your generous donations, from October through December of 2019, St. Dominic's SVdP provided \$17,948.35 in aid to 86 of our neighborhood families made up of 311 adults and children. The breakdown of the aid that was given is as follows:

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR – The application process for applying for financial assistance for the 2020-2021 school year is now open. If you have a high school student next year, and you have applied for assistance through FACTS, you do not have to complete the application for your St. Dominic student, as long as you have selected St. Dominic as one of your schools. *PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU HAVE SELECTED ST. DOMINIC AS ONE OF YOUR SCHOOLS.*

To begin the application process, go to: **www.factsmgmt.com**. In the upper left corner of the page, click on "Parent Log In." If you applied for assistance last year (2019-2020), your login credentials will be the same. If you are utilizing FACTS for tuition payment processing for this current school year, your login credentials are the same. Click on the link, "Apply for Financial Aid." The instructions for completing the application are relatively intuitive, however if you experience any issues please contact FACTS at (866) 412-4637.

Awards will be granted first through the Catholic Education Foundation (The Archdiocese of Cincinnati's One Faith One Hope One Love Campaign). CEF awards will be announced in February 2020. St. Dominic will announce Parish awards in the Spring of 2020. **The deadline to apply for assistance is January 31, 2020 for CEF and St. Dominic Parish Awards. No exceptions can be made!** You will need your 2018 tax return information. You will also have to upload pages 1 and 2 from your 2018 tax return as well as copies of any 2018 W-2's.
