ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) REGISTRATION FOR 2021/2022



We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in

their task of raising their children in the Faith.

Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2021/2022 school year is online. All registrations must be submitted by September 8. Access the online registration form via the parish website at www.stdominicdelhi.org. Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. *There will be no fee for PSR for the 2021-2022 school year.*

The first day of class for all grades (1-8) is Sunday, September 12 at 10:30 a.m.

Upon registration, families will receive the PSR calendars for grades 1-8, as well as the PSR Handbook. If you have any questions about PSR, you can contact Megan Mattei, PSR Coordinator, at mmattei@stdominicdelhi.org or 865-607-2070.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Considering Entering the Catholic Church?

RCIA is the process through which adults are fully initiated into the Catholic faith community. The process provides for different levels of entry. To obtain more information, call Deacon Mark Bardonaro at 471–7741.

Infant Baptisms

Attendance at a Parent Pre-Baptism Session is required. Call the Parish Office at 471-7741, ext. 0.

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Every Saturday, 8:45 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or by appointment.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN

SafeParish is the new child protection platform for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. All volunteers and employees in the Archdiocese of Cincinnati with an active child protection account should have received an email from SafeParish inviting them to register for their new SafeParish account. These emails were sent during the week of July 12. If you did not receive the email, please check your spam or junk mail folders. You can also find a copy of the SafeParish registration instructions by going to the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Safe Environment Office webpage at https://catholicaoc.org/offices/safe-environment. Click on "Top Resources" then click on the link for "SafeParish."

All new volunteers should follow the SafeParish registration instructions for creating a SafeParish account. During the registration process, new volunteers will be invited to complete their background check and child protection training online. The \$25.00 fee for this can be paid by credit card or with a "token." Contact the organization for which you volunteer to get information on obtaining a token for payment. 
