
Considering Entering the Catholic Church?

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Starting July 1, we will be part of a larger parish family! Our Family of parishes will include Our Lady of Victory, St. Simon, St. Al's on-the-Ohio, and St. Vincent de Paul. I was pleased with our grouping, five churches and two strong schools! In January or February, three priests will be officially assigned to this family, a pastor and two associates. Clearly, they will need the continued help of the retired priests in the area. I will probably not be assigned pastor of the family. They do not assign eighty year-old priests to a new pastorate! But I am expecting that Fr. Chris, Deacon Mark and I will continue over the next five or six years to be involved with the life and operations here at St. Dominic. Looking at the statistics of the five parishes, e.g. attendance, participation, finances, Baptisms, etc., it is clear that we are a rock in the family.
