Marriage, Divorce and Declaration of Nullity (Annulment)

Join Fr. Jim and Deacon Mark Bardonaro on Tuesday, January 16, in the Faith Sharing Room of the Parish Center at 7:00 p.m. for a discussion on marriage, divorce and annulments. We will examine what the Church says about marriage and what happens when a marriage ends in divorce. We will detail the declaration of nullity process: What is it? When is it necessary? We are offering this evening in an attempt to bring about a deeper understanding of all marriages. Come join us!

Parental Preparation for Infant Baptism

Parents requesting Baptism of their first child are asked to attend a preparation session. During this time, we will look at the history and theology of the sacrament, reflect on our own Baptism, and look at ways to pass the Catholic faith on to our children. Godparents are encouraged to attend as well. Our next session is scheduled for Sunday, February 4 at 10:30 a.m. (after the 9:30 a.m. Mass) in church. RCIA Update

On Sunday, October 29 we celebrated the Rites of Acceptance and Welcoming at the 9:30 a.m. Mass at St. Dominic and at the 8:45 a.m. Mass at Our Lady of Victory. Even though the Mary, Queen of All Saints RCIA meets at St. Dominic, certain rites are more appropriately celebrated in the parishes of the participants. It is the parish community who acknowledges, accepts, welcomes, and promises to support these men, women, and children as they journey toward Baptism and full initiation in the Catholic Church.

At St. Dominic, we had eight people who were accepted into the Catechumenate at the Rite of Acceptance, and seven others who are already baptized in various Christian traditions and now seek to be fully initiated in the Roman Catholic Church.

Currently, Mary Queen of All Saints has fifteen Catechumens and several infants planning for Baptism at the Easter Vigil, and twenty-six preparing for Confirmation.

Clearly, our parishes and the Church continue to be blessed by men and women interested in joining us in the Catholic faith. Because we have a year-round RCIA process, we are able to begin meeting with an interested person whenever the time is right for that person. Many people experience God's call at events such as weddings, funerals, and Baptisms, as well as the seasons of Christmas and Easter. It normally comes about through the words and witness of others. If you think someone may be interested in learning more about the Catholic faith, invite them to Mass, or even some other parish function.
