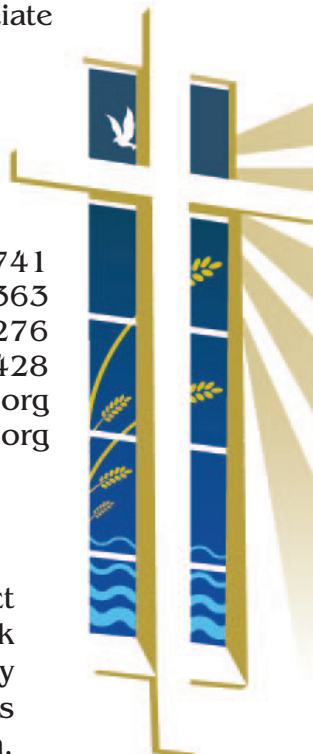

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Good stewardship invites us always to reflect on our use of our time. Our time is a gift from God. Good stewardship means giving thanks for the time we have. It also means giving God some of our "prime time." You will have an opportunity to do just that on Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday of this coming week!

Lent ends at sunset on Holy Thursday. The *Triduum* (Latin word for "three days") begins. Though we call this time the "Three Days," in spirit, it is really one event. What we start on Holy Thursday, we finish on Easter Sunday. These three days are the heart of our liturgical year; when we reflect on and celebrate the events that bring us salvation and eternal life. May I suggest that you plan now for how you will spend these three days. During these three days, everything is important and significant. What you do... where you go... what you eat... and with whom you spend your time. Your choices from Thursday to Sunday will be an indication of what your priorities are. Chart how you spend your time during those days and you will see what you value.

My hope is that you will choose to spend some of the time with your brothers and sisters in the Lord, i.e., your fellow parishioners! St. Dominic parish will be gathering on Holy Thursday night, Good Friday afternoon and evening, Saturday night for the Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday. These gatherings are central to who we are as a community of faith. I especially invite you to gather with us for the Easter Vigil on Saturday night. This is the most significant gathering of the year for us as a parish. May this holiest week of the year be a time of grace for each of you.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

Quarterly Training Bulletin Due by April 24, 2022

SafeParish is the child protection platform for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. All new volunteers should follow the SafeParish registration instructions for creating a SafeParish account. You can find a copy of the SafeParish registration instructions and a link to SafeParish on our website at www.stdominichelhi.org. Click on the SafeParish button on the left side of the page.

During the registration process, new volunteers will be invited to complete their background check and child protection training online. The \$25.00 fee for this can be paid by credit card or with a "token." Contact the parish ministry for which you volunteer to get information on obtaining a token for payment. WEEKLY EMAILS

Each Tuesday, SafeParish sends an email regarding the updated child protection and workplace safety articles that are posted on the SafeParish website. These articles are NOT required but are recommended reading.

QUARTERLY BULLETINS

Everyone registered with SafeParish should have received the quarterly video. The training bulletin must be completed by April 24, 2022 in order to remain active and in compliance with the Archdiocese of Cincinnati Child Protection Policy.

No one may work with children if they are not active and in compliance. If you did not get the bulletin, check your spam or junk mail. You can also sign into your account, go to the "Training" tab and click on the "Due" link to see which bulletins are due and their due dates.
