Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN

SafeParish is the new child protection platform for the Archdiocese of Cincinnati. You can find a copy of the SafeParish registration instructions on our website at www.stdominicdelhi. org and click on the SafeParish button on the left side of the page.

All **new** volunteers should follow the SafeParish registration instructions for creating a SafeParish account. During the registration process, new volunteers will be invited to complete their background check and child protection training online. The \$25.00 fee for this can be paid by credit card or with a "token." Contact the organization for which you volunteer to get information on obtaining a token for payment.

QUARTERLY BULLETINS – Emails will come from SafeParish notifying users of the quarterly training which will also appear in their account under training that is due. Users can check for training that is due after logging into their SafeParish account by going to the Training Tab and clicking on the "Due" link to see which bulletins are due and their due date.


Online Giving is available for parishioners with WeShare, an easy and convenient way to save time and support the church. Donating is simple, safe, and completely secure.
