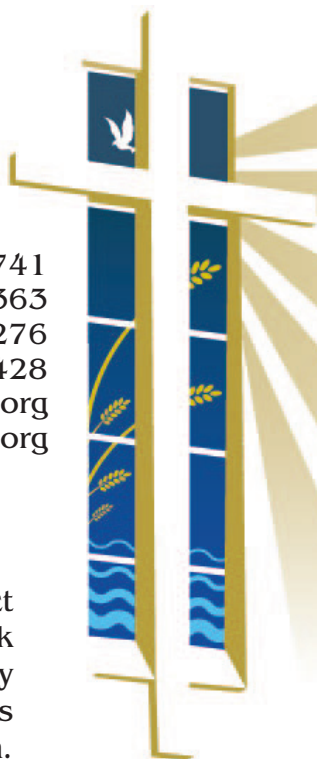

Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) 2019/2020 REGISTRATION

We will have registration in the Gathering Place after all Masses the weekends of August 3/4 and August 10/11.



The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God's love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – family, the Parish community of Faith, the larger community and the world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2019/2020 school year will be online and after all the Masses on August 3/4 and 10/11. All registrations must be submitted by August 30.

Access the online registration form via the Parish Website (www.stdominicedelhi.org). Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student, with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August 30.

The first day of class for all grades (1-8) is Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m.

There will be a parent meeting on Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m. in Teal Hall.

NOTE: Classes for grades 7 & 8 are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.

Thank You to all the parishioners of St. Dominic. Because of your generous donations, from April through June 2019, the St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Dominic helped 54 families, made up of 144 adults and children, in our service area which includes Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside.

Remember that St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Conference has NO overhead, personnel or office expenses. Every cent that is donated to the St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society is used to help our neighbors. The gift will be acknowledged by a handwritten note to the recipient. The honoree will know you have honored them with a gift to help the needy in our area.

St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul's total receipts for the second quarter of 2019 were \$10,142 from the poor box collections, the parishioner donations, the schoolchildren, and member donations. Parishioners donated \$3,060 by using the St. Vincent de Paul envelopes included with the St. Dominic Parish envelopes. As always, we thank the St. Dominic School children for all the food that they donate each month to help us feed our neighbors.

Because there were funds left over from previous quarters, The St. Vincent de Paul Society at St. Dominic was able to provide \$11,445 in aid to our neighbors during the months of April through June of 2019. The breakdown is as follows:
