Through the generous support of our parishioners, we were able to provide just over \$60,000 in financial assistance for our school families. Additionally, we continued to replace aging floor tiles in several classrooms; we were able to air condition most of the school prior to the start of the 2020-21 school year. We had planned and budgeted for a Fall Festival during October 2020 and a Spring Festival May 2021, however, we had to cancel both events due to Covid. Instead, we held (3) Major Awards/Split the Pots during the fiscal period which netted us over \$92,000 mitigating more than two-thirds of the potential revenue loss.
