ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR) 2019/2020 REGISTRATION

There will be a parent meeting on Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m. in Teal Hall.

NOTE: Classes for grades 7 and 8 are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.


