One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

2019/2020 REGISTRATION**

**We will have registration in the Gathering Place after all Masses this weekend, August 3/4, and next weekend, August 10/11.**

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR).

Registration for the 2019/2020 school year will be online and after all the Masses on August 3/4 and 10/11. All registrations must be submitted by August 30.

Access the online registration form via the Parish Website ([www.stdominicdelhi.org](http://www.stdominicdelhi.org)). Click on the PSR Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee per child will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August 30.

**The first day of class for all grades (1-8) is Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m.**

**There will be a parent meeting on Sunday, September 8 at 10:30 a.m. in Teal Hall.**

**NOTE: Classes for grades 7 and 8 are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.**

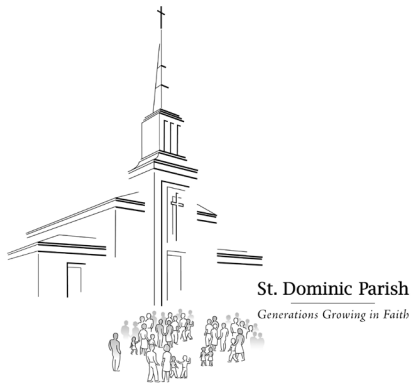
