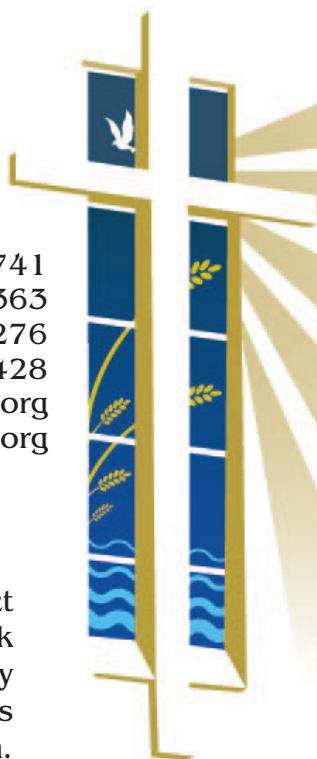

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

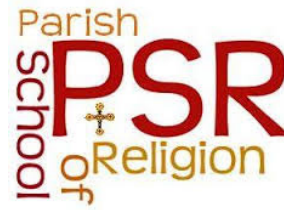

There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.
