REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN

As a reminder, all volunteers are required to attend one VIRTUS live training session. You can attend this training at any location at a date/time that works best for you. The second requirement for volunteers is to complete an online background check request. Payment for this is by credit card or "token" at the time of your online request.
