#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Archbishop Schnurr and the Ohio bishops have reinstated the obligation to attend Sunday and Holy Day Mass, beginning with the Sunday Masses of June 5 and 6, 2021.

Here is a quote from the bishops of Ohio: "As has always been the case, those who have a serious reason are exempt from attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. This includes those who are ill, as well as those who have significant fear or anxiety of contracting the coronavirus in a large group of persons."

The value underlying the obligation is that the Mass is the "source and summit of the Christian life!" We are most the Body of Christ when we gather and celebrate Mass. We are in right relationship with our God and one another when we join with Christ in the Spirit and offer the sacrifice of the Mass! There is no mask mandate for churches of the archdiocese after June 2. We will honor that at St. Dominic. I am assuming that those who are not vaccinated will still choose to wear a mask for the sake of others. For the present, our Eucharistic Ministers will continue to wear a mask when distributing and sanitize hands before. We will continue to have sanitizer at the doors as you will be using hymnals. We will continue to livestream our Masses. We will continue to use the cry room for Saturday morning Confessions. However, it will double as a cry room for the weekend Masses. It looks like we are coming to the end of this pandemic! Praise the Lord! I want to thank you all for your cooperation in wearing masks and looking out for your neighbor. Thank you for your financial support during this past year. We welcome you back with great joy!

Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.


