# SIGN OF PEACE AND COMMUNION FROM THE CUP DURING FLU SEASON

# OPEN HOUSE AT ST. DOMINIC SCHOOL TO CELEBRATE CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK



**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR** – The application process for applying for financial assistance for the 2019-2020 school year is now open. If you have a high school student next year, and you have applied for assistance through FACTS, you do not have to complete the application for your St. Dominic student, as long as you have selected St. Dominic as one of your schools. *PLEASE MAKE CERTAIN YOU HAVE SELECTED ST. DOMINIC AS ONE OF YOUR SCHOOLS.* 

To begin the application process, go to **www.factsmgt.com**. In the upper left corner of the page, click on "Parent Log In". If you applied for assistance last year (2018-2019), your login credentials will be the same. If you are utilizing FACTS for tuition payment processing for this current school year, your login credentials are the same. Click on the link, "Apply for Financial Aid". The instructions for completing the application are relatively intuitive, however, if you experience any issues, please contact FACTS at (866) 412-4637.

Awards will first be granted through the Catholic Education Foundation (The Archdiocese of Cincinnati's One Faith One Hope One Love Campaign). CEF awards will be announced in February 2019. St. Dominic will announce Parish awards in the Spring of 2019. The deadline to apply for assistance is January 31, 2019 for CEF and St. Dominic Parish Awards. No exceptions can be made! You will need your 2017 tax return information. You will also have to upload pages 1 AND 2 from your 2017 tax return as well as copies of any 2017 W-2s.
