ST. DOMINIC-DELHI KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

The St. Dominic-Delhi Knights of Columbus have purchased a kiosk for the parish containing booklets from the "Building the Domestic Church" series of the Catholic Information Service, which is provided by the national office of the K of C. This series presents some of the most popular CIS resources aimed at helping us to live out the Church's mission and vision for our families. Series topics include: parenting, fatherhood and family prayer life, as well as two of St. John Paul II's famous messages for the family – "Letter to Families" and "The Family in the Modern World." Other titles include "The Gift of Fatherhood," "God's Plan for Love and Marriage," and "Faith: Questions and Answers." The kiosk is located in the hallway by the school, between the church and the Gathering Place. Feel free to take booklets that interest you. Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Sick is a healing sacrament of the Church. Anyone who is sick or elderly and in need of physical or emotional healing can come to this sacrament which will be communally celebrated annually. Those who would like to receive the sacrament before a hospital stay or surgery are invited to call the Parish Office to make arrangements. The sacrament is also available to those who may be near death. Please call the parish emergency line. Someone will respond to your call. Please inform the Parish Office when a member of the parish is hospitalized.

Sacrament of Matrimony

One of the engaged or his/her parents must be a registered and active parishioner for six months prior to scheduling a wedding. Scheduling must take place at least six months in advance of the wedding. Weddings are not scheduled during Advent or Lenten Seasons. A marriage preparation program is required.

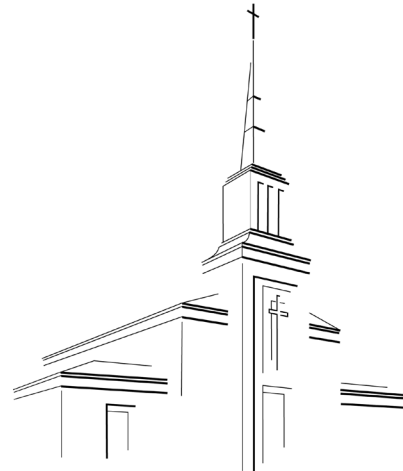
