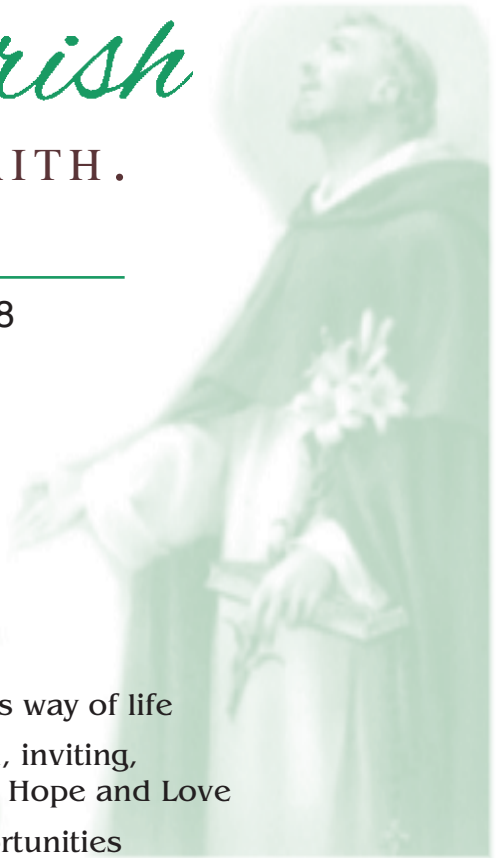

**ST. DOMINIC PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION (PSR)  
 REGISTRATION FOR 2018/2019**



The mission of the St. Dominic Parish Community is the same as the mission of the greater Church – to bring about a connection with and response to God’s love in our world – and truly live out the Reign of God. We do this through the Sacraments, Scripture, Prayer and our interconnections with others – the

family, the Parish community of Faith and the larger community and world.

We welcome all registered parish families whose children attend public schools to attend our Parish School of Religion (PSR). The PSR staff and teachers are here to assist parents in their task of raising their children in the Faith. Instruction in PSR is offered during the school year (September-May) for children in grades 1-8. There is special emphasis on the sacramental years, usually 2nd, 7th and 8th grades, with added activities for parents and candidates.

Registration for the 2018/2019 school year will be online. **All registrations must be submitted by August 31.**

Access the online registration form via the Parish Website ([www.stdominicdelhi.org](http://www.stdominicdelhi.org)). Click on the PSR, Registration button on the left side. The cost for grades 1-8 is \$50/per student with a maximum of \$150/per family. All fees are due at registration. A \$10 late fee will be assessed if payment is not made in full by August 31.

First day of Class:

Grades 1-6: Sunday, September 9 at 10:30 a.m.

Grades 7-8: Tuesday, September 11 at 7:00 p.m.

**NOTE: Grade 6 classes are moving from Tuesday evenings to Sunday mornings this year.**

**ST. DOMINIC ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY**

**Thank You to all the parishioners of St. Dominic.** Because of your generous donations, from April through June of 2018, the St. Dominic St. Vincent de Paul Society helped 69 families, made up of 228 adults and children, in our service area which includes Delhi, Sedamsville and Riverside.

**St. Vincent de Paul Society’s total receipts for the second quarter of 2018 were \$11,536.50** from the poor box collections, the parishioner donations, the schoolchildren, and the member donations. Parishioners donated \$1,804.00 by using the St. Vincent de Paul envelopes included with the St. Dominic Parish envelopes. We received a nice donation from St. Vincent de Paul Parish since they do not have an SVdP conference and St. Dominic’s SVdP serves their clients in Sedamsville and Riverside.

**Bill Rasmussen**, who previously was very active with St. Dominic’s St. Vincent de Paul Society, died a couple of months ago, but his legacy to St. Dominic’s SVdP continues because there have been **many, many donations to St. Dominic’s SVdP in Bill’s memory.** We thank Cathy, Bill’s wife, for requesting that donations be made to St. Dominic’s SVdP in Bill’s memory. St. Dominic’s SVdP has been able to help many needy families because of Cathy’s thoughtfulness and the many generous friends who remember what Bill stood for and followed his example.

As always, we thank the St. Dominic School children for all the food that they donated each month to help us feed our neighbors.
